

# Youth Trail Worker (2 Positions) SLDA'sLabrador Pioneer Footpath project

# **Summary:**

SLDA is seeking youth trail workers for completion of phase 2 of the Labrador Pioneer Footpath project. Phase 2 consists of trail construction and upgrading from L'Anse au Clair to Pinware.

### **Responsibilities:**

- To work on SLDA's Labrador Pioneer Footpath
- Performs other related work as may be required.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Must be able to do physical labour work & some heavy lifting
- Asset:Experience in trail work, use of various tools and equipment, and some carpentry skills
  are assets.

## **Working Conditions:**

- The wage is \$24 an hour
- 40 hours per week, for 10-12 weeks
- On-the-job training will be provided to the successful candidates
