



Youth Trail Worker (2 Positions)

Summary:

The Southern Labrador Development Association (SLDA) is a non-profit organization that, for more than fifty years, has been a leader in the Labrador Straits in social and economic development. SLDA is seeking youth trail workers for completion of phase 2 of the Labrador Pioneer Footpath project. Phase 2 consists of trail construction and upgrading from L'Anse au Clair to Pinware.

Responsibilities:

- To work on SLDA's Labrador Pioneer Footpath
- Performs other related work as may be required.

Qualifications:

- Must be able to do physical labour work & some heavy lifting
- **Asset:** Experience in trail work, use of various tools and equipment, and some carpentry skills are assets.

Working Conditions:

- The wage is \$24 an hour
- 40 hours per week, for 10-12 weeks
- On-the-job training will be provided to the successful candidates

Note:

- Workers are responsible for suitable clothing and gear for outdoor work and travel to nearest trailhead of the trail section under construction.
